

SPPC String Theory Fun Shoot – 2-16-2024



On our February education night, we held a String Theory Macro Fun Shoot. LeeAnn had put together a nice kit that we received as we signed in. The kit included everything that was needed for the fun shoot, including a cool waterproof multicolored light puck. LeeAnn then gave some basic instructions on depth of field and shutter speed and suggested settings for the macro shoot. We were able to mimic the setup she had, or we could follow the detailed instructions in our kit on how to set up our tables or try one of the suggested variations.





The kits could be reused at home to try out with different effects. Basically, we were to have our puck light set behind the string "web" with several different reflective surfaces behind that. We could also place a small ornament behind the string so that it could be reflected in the water droplets on the strings. Combinations were limitless and creativity filled the room.

There were a lot of members and a couple guests that night. I am sure many will find more opportunities to use the contents of our macro kit on other tabletop shoots.



In May 2023 my wife and I took a quick 10-day trip to South Dakota. We visited the Badlands in eastern SD, the Black Hills area in western SD and ventured into Wyoming to see Devil's Tower. We stayed in Wall, SD for 2 nights. Yes, we went to Wall Drug which has a very interesting back story. They gave away free ice water to weary travelers driving out to see the new Mt Rushmore carving! The rest is history! The Badlands were interesting for their rugged landscape features.

We did see a few mountain goats climbing in the area. Then we drove west to the Black Hills area but the smoke from the Canadian wildfires was fairly heavy and obscured some of our photos. We did see Mt. Rushmore, Custer State Park, and a mammoth archaeological dig site.

Custer has a very large buffalo herd that just roams free throughout the 71,000 acres.



Because my wife is a quilter on the way home, we stopped in Winterset, Iowa to visit the Iowa Quilt Museum. We discovered that Winterset is in the county seat of Madison County and there were about 7 covered bridges there – hence the movie.

Springtime Flower Photography Tips

It's springtime and in Michigan that means (more than likely), cloudy days or even rainy days. That's actually not bad news. Clouds make for a natural diffuser and will give better color for your images.

Raindrops can add interest to flowers as well. Make sure you check the weather though and bring protection for your camera and gear.

Tips -

Get in close. Practice those macro skills and highlight those small details in the flower. Treat the center of the flower like you would eyes on a person. Keep it sharp.

Shoot from different angles. Possibly from the back if there are a lot of details to showcase on the backside of the flower. Try to isolate your subject against complementary or contrasting colors as your background.
